This topic of the Holy Spirit is a summary of every biblical reference I could find to the Holy Spirit. Sometimes verses are omitted if they are exact duplicates, such as a New Testament verse quoting an old testament verse. Some references are duplicated if they fit in more than one category. Also, some references may not be necessarily true, for instance, if something about the Spirit were spoken by a friend of Job.

Many more hours could be done here to organize and categorize all of the different verses which give mention to the Holy Spirit. But I have assembled a good starting place to help us visualize what a complete systematic theology of the Holy Spirit might look like.

This research may be used freely.

### Part 1: Attributes of the Holy Spirit

- Contrary to the flesh
  - Romans 8:9 "You, however, are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit."
  - Romans 8:13 "For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live."
  - Galatians 5:17 "For the flesh desires what is against the Spirit, and the Spirit desires what is against the flesh; these are opposed to each other"
  - 1 Corinthians 3:1 "Brothers and sisters, I could not address you as people who live by the Spirit but as people who are still worldly—mere infants in Christ."
  - Galatians 3:3 "After beginning by means of the Spirit, are you now trying to finish by means of the flesh?"
  - Galatians 4:29 "At that time the son born according to the flesh persecuted the son born by the power of the Spirit. It is the same now."
  - Galatians 5:16 "So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh."
  - Galatians 6:8 "Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life."
  - Jude 1:19 "These are the people who divide you, who follow mere natural instincts and do not have the Spirit."
- Contrary to the law
  - Romans 2:29 "circumcision is circumcision of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the written code."
  - 2 Corinthians 3:6 "for the letter kills, but the Spirit produces life."
  - Galatians 5:18 "But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law."

- Galatians 5:23 "Against [the fruit of the Spirit] there is no law."
- Has a mind - Romans 8:27 "And He who searches the hearts knows the Spirit's mind-set"
- Universal among all believers/Brings unity among believers
  - 1 Corinthians 12:4 "Now there are different gifts, but the same Spirit."
  - 1 Corinthians 12:13 "For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body— whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free"
  - Ephesians 4:3-4 "Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit"
  - Philippians 1:27 "I will know that you stand firm in the one Spirit, striving together as one for the faith of the gospel"
  - Philippians 2:1-2 "if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind."
- Can be grieved
  - Ephesians 4:30 "And don't grieve God's Holy Spirit." After this Paul tells us to put away sinfulness.
  - Isaiah 63:10 "But they rebelled, and grieved His Holy Spirit."
  - Hebrews 10:29 "How much more severely do you think someone deserves to be punished who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, who has treated as an unholy thing the blood of the covenant that sanctified them, and who has insulted the Spirit of grace?"
- Can be stifled - 1 Thessalonians 5:19 "Don't stifle the Spirit." NIV uses "quench"
- Has a Desire - Romans 8:4-5 "because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death. Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires."
- Is Lord - 2 Corinthians 3:17 "Now the Lord is the Spirit." Again 3:18. This gives us reason to believe that the Holy Spirit is part of the trinity.
- Is of great qualities
  - Isaiah 11:2 "The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him— the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the Lord—"
- Can be given rest - Zechariah 6:8 "Then he called to me, 'Look, those going toward the north country have given my Spirit rest in the land of the north.'" (The word "Spirit" here is not the Holy Spirit in a strict sense.)
- Holy - Romans 1:4 "and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by his resurrection from the dead"
- Always Present - 1 Corinthians 3:16 "Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in your midst?"

## **Part 2: Function of the Holy Spirit:**

- Gives us truth/Tells us things
  - Just about any reference of prophecy in the category above could also go here.
  - John 14:17 "He is the Spirit of truth."
  - John 14:26 "The Holy Spirit... will teach you all things and remind you of everything I have told you."

- John 16:13 "But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. "
- John 16:15 "All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will receive from me what he will make known to you."
- 1 Chronicles 28:12 "He gave him the plans of all that the Spirit had put in his mind for the courts of the temple of the Lord"
- Nehemiah 9:20 "You gave your good Spirit to instruct them."
- Nehemiah 9:30 "By your Spirit you warned them through your prophets."
- Ezekiel 2:2 "As he spoke, the Spirit came into me and raised me to my feet, and I heard him speaking to me."
- Zechariah 7:12 "They made their hearts as hard as flint and would not listen to the law or to the words that the Lord Almighty had sent by his Spirit through the earlier prophets."
- Luke 2:25-26 "He was waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was on him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not die before he had seen the Lord's Messiah."
- John 1:33 "And I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, 'The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and remain is the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.'"
- Acts 8:29 "The Spirit told Philip, 'Go to that chariot and stay near it.'"
- Acts 10:19 "While Peter was still thinking about the vision, the Spirit said to him, 'Simon, three men are looking for you.'"
- Acts 11:12 "The Spirit told me to have no hesitation about going with them."
- Acts 13:2 "While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, 'Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.'"
- Acts 20:23 "I only know that in every city the Holy Spirit warns me that prison and hardships are facing me."
- 1 Corinthians 2:10 "these are the things God has revealed to us by his Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God."
- 1 Corinthians 2:14 "The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit."
- Ephesians 3:5 "which was not made known to people in other generations as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to God's holy apostles and prophets."
- Ephesians 6:17 "the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God."
- Colossians 1:9 "We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives,"
- 1 Timothy 4:1 "The Spirit clearly says that in later times some will abandon the faith"
- Hebrews 3:7 "So, as the Holy Spirit says:"
- Hebrews 9:8 "The Holy Spirit was showing by this that the way into the Most Holy Place had not yet been disclosed"
- Revelation 2:7 "Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches." Again v11, 17, 29, 3:6, 13, 22
- Revelation 14:13 "Then I heard a voice from heaven say, 'Write this: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.' 'Yes,' says the Spirit, 'they will rest from their labor, for their deeds will follow them.'"
- Speaks through us
  - Acts 1:16 "the Scripture had to be fulfilled in which the Holy Spirit spoke long ago through David concerning Judas"

- John 3:34 "For the one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the Spirit without limit."
- Acts 1:2 "until the day he was taken up to heaven, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles he had chosen."
- 2 Peter 1:21 "Because no prophecy ever came by the will of man; instead, moved by the Holy Spirit, men spoke from God."
- 2 Samuel 23:2 "The Spirit of the Lord spoke through me; his word was on my tongue."
- Luke 1:41-42 "and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit. In a loud voice she exclaimed: 'Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the child you will bear!'"
- Acts 6:10 "But they could not stand up against the wisdom the Spirit gave him as he spoke"
- Acts 11:28 "One of them, named Agabus, stood up and through the Spirit predicted that a severe famine would spread over the entire Roman world."
- Acts 13:9 "Then Saul, who was also called Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, looked straight at Elymas and said,"
- Acts 21:4 "Through the Spirit they urged Paul not to go on to Jerusalem."
- Acts 21:11 "Coming over to us, he took Paul's belt, tied his own hands and feet with it and said, "The Holy Spirit says, 'In this way the Jewish leaders in Jerusalem will bind the owner of this belt and will hand him over to the Gentiles.'""
- Acts 28:25 "The Holy Spirit spoke the truth to your ancestors when he said through Isaiah the prophet:"
- 1 Corinthians 2:13 "This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, explaining spiritual realities with Spirit-taught words."
- 1 Corinthians 12:3 "Therefore I want you to know that no one who is speaking by the Spirit of God says, 'Jesus be cursed,' and no one can say, 'Jesus is Lord,' except by the Holy Spirit."
- 1 Corinthians 14:37 "If anyone thinks they are a prophet or otherwise gifted by the Spirit"
- 1 Peter 1:11 "[The prophets were] trying to find out the time and circumstances to which the Spirit of Christ in them was pointing when he predicted the sufferings of the Messiah and the glories that would follow."
- Lives in us
  - Romans 8:9 "the Spirit of God lives in you."
  - 1 Corinthians 6:19 "Do you not know that your body is a sanctuary of the Holy Spirit who is in you"
  - Ephesians 2:22 "in whom you are also being built together for God's dwelling in the Spirit.
  - John 7:38-39 "'Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them.' By this he meant the Spirit"
  - John 14:17 "But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you."
  - 1 Corinthians 6:19 "Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own"
  - 1 Peter 1:11 "trying to find out the time and circumstances to which the Spirit of Christ in them was pointing when he predicted the sufferings of the Messiah and the glories that would follow."
- Testifies with us
  - Romans 8:16 "The Spirit Himself testifies together with our spirit that we are God's children"

- Matthew 10:20 "for it will not be you speaking, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you."
- Matthew 22:43 "How is it then that David, speaking by the Spirit, calls him 'Lord'" Again Mark 12:36
- Mark 3:11 "Whenever you are arrested and brought to trial, do not worry beforehand about what to say. Just say whatever is given you at the time, for it is not you speaking, but the Holy Spirit." Again Luke 12:12
- Acts 4:8 "Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them"
- Acts 5:32 "We are witnesses of these things, and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him."
- Romans 9:1 "I speak the truth in Christ—I am not lying, my conscience confirms it through the Holy Spirit"
- 1 Thessalonians 1:5 "because our gospel came to you not simply with words but also with power, with the Holy Spirit and deep conviction."
- Hebrews 10:14-15 "For by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy. The Holy Spirit also testifies to us about this."
- 1 Peter 1:12 "by those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven."
- 1 John 5:6-8 "And it is the Spirit who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth .For there are three that testify: the Spirit, the water and the blood; and the three are in agreement."
- Revelation 19:10 "I am a fellow servant with you and with your brothers and sisters who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For it is the Spirit of prophecy who bears testimony to Jesus."
- Revelation 22:17 "The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let the one who hears say, "Come!" Let the one who is thirsty come; and let the one who wishes take the free gift of the water of life."
- Helps and intercedes for us
  - Romans 8:26-27 "In the same way, the Spirit also joins to help in our weakness, because we do not know what to pray for as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with unspoken groanings. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God."
  - Numbers 11:17 "I will take some of the Spirit who is on you and put the Spirit on them. They will help you bear the burden of the people"
  - 1 Samuel 19:20-23 - This passage talks about how soldiers of Saul were basically prevented from harming David because the Spirit of God kept causing them to prophesy.
  - Isaiah 48:16 "And now the Sovereign Lord has sent me, endowed with his Spirit."
  - Daniel 4:8-9 "Finally, Daniel came into my presence and I told him the dream. (He is called Belteshazzar, after the name of my god, and the spirit of the holy gods is in him.) I said, "Belteshazzar, chief of the magicians, I know that the spirit of the holy gods is in you, and no mystery is too difficult for you. Here is my dream; interpret it for me." Again 4:18, 5:11, 5:14
  - Haggai 2:4-5 "'Be strong... For I am with you,' declares the Lord Almighty...'And my Spirit remains among you. Do not fear.'"
  - Acts 1:8 "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you"
  - Acts 4:31 "And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly."

- Acts 9:31 "Then the church throughout Judea, Galilee and Samaria enjoyed a time of peace and was strengthened. Living in the fear of the Lord and encouraged by the Holy Spirit, it increased in numbers."
- 1 Corinthians 2:4 "My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power"
- 2 Timothy 1:14 "Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you—guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in us."
- Galatians 4:6 "Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, 'Abba, Father.'"
- Evidence for salvation
  - 1 Corinthians 12:3 "no one speaking by the Spirit of God says, 'Jesus is cursed,' and no one can say, 'Jesus is Lord,' except by the Holy Spirit.
  - John 7:38-39 "'Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them.' By this he meant the Spirit"
  - Acts 15:8 "God, who knows the heart, showed that he accepted them by giving the Holy Spirit to them, just as he did to us."
  - 2 Thessalonians 2:3 "God chose you as firstfruits to be saved through the sanctifying work of the Spirit and through belief in the truth."
  - 1 John 3:24 "And this is how we know that he lives in us: We know it by the Spirit he gave us."
  - 1 John 4:13 "This is how we know that we live in him and he in us: He has given us of his Spirit."
  - Acts 19:1-7 "He found some disciples and asked them, 'Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?' 'No,' they told him, 'we haven't even heard that there is a Holy Spirit.' 'Then with what baptism were you baptized?' he asked them. 'With John's baptism,' they replied. Paul said, 'John baptized with a baptism of repentance, telling the people that they should believe in the One who would come after him, that is, in Jesus.' On hearing this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they began to speak with other languages and to prophesy."
- Physical Life
  - Genesis 6:3 "My Spirit will not remain with mankind forever, because they are corrupt. Their days will be 120 years."
  - Romans 8:11 "And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, then He who raised Christ from the dead will also bring your mortal bodies to life through His Spirit who lives in you."
  - Job 33:4 "The Spirit of God has made me; the breath of the Almighty gives me life."
  - Job 34:14 "If it were his intention and he withdrew his spirit and breath, all humanity would perish together and mankind would return to the dust."
  - Psalm 104:30 "When you send your Spirit, they are created"
  - Romans 8:11 "And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you."
  - 1 Peter 3:18 "[Jesus] was put to death in the body but made alive in the Spirit."
- Spiritual Life
  - 2 Corinthians 3:6 "He has made us competent as ministers of a new covenant—not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit produces life."

- 1 Samuel 10:6 "The Spirit of the Lord will come powerfully upon you ...and you will be changed into a different person."
- Psalm 143:10 "may your good Spirit lead me on level ground."
- Isaiah 32:15 "till the Spirit is poured on us from on high, and the desert becomes a fertile field, and the fertile field seems like a forest."
- Isaiah 63:14 "like cattle that go down to the plain, they were given rest by the Spirit of the Lord."
- Ezekiel 37:13-14 "Then you, my people, will know that I am the Lord, when I open your graves and bring you up from them. I will put my Spirit in you and you will live"
- Luke 10:21 "At that time Jesus, full of joy through the Holy Spirit,"
- John 3:6 "Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit."
- John 6:63 "The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you—they are full of the Spirit and life."
- Romans 8:6 "The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace."
- Romans 8:10 "even though your body is subject to death because of sin, the Spirit gives life because of righteousness."
- Romans 8:13 "For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live."
- Romans 14:17 "For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit"
- Romans 15:13 "so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit."
- 1 Corinthians 12:13 "and we were all given the one Spirit to drink."
- 1 Thessalonians 1:6 "for you welcomed the message in the midst of severe suffering with the joy given by the Holy Spirit."
- Titus 3:5-6 "He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior"
- Causes us to follow God/God's will
  - Ezekiel 36:27 "I will place my Spirit within you and cause you to follow My statutes and carefully observe My ordinances."
  - Galatians 5:16 "walk by the Spirit and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh."
  - Galatians 5:22-23 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, gentleness, self-control."
  - 1 Samuel 16:13 "So Samuel took the horn of oil, anointed him in the presence of his brothers, and the Spirit of the Lord took control of David from that day forward."
  - Judges 3:10 "The Spirit of the Lord came on him, so that he became Israel's judge and went to war."
  - Judges 6:34 "Then the Spirit of the Lord came on Gideon, and he blew a trumpet, summoning the Abiezrites to follow him."
  - Judges 11:29 "Then the Spirit of the Lord came on Jephthah. He crossed Gilead and Manasseh, passed through Mizpah of Gilead, and from there he advanced against the Ammonites."
  - Judges 13:25 "and the Spirit of the Lord began to stir him while he was in Mahaneh Dan"
  - 1 Chronicles 12:8 "Then the Spirit came on Amasai, chief of the Thirty, and he said: 'We are yours, David! We are with you, son of Jesse! Success, success to you, and success to those who help you, for your God will help you.'"
  - Acts 16:6-7 "Paul and his companions traveled throughout the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been kept by the Holy Spirit from preaching the word in the province of

Asia. When they came to the border of Mysia, they tried to enter Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus would not allow them to."

- Philippians 3:3 "we who serve God by his Spirit"
- Takes us places
  - Ezekiel 37:1 "He brought me out by His Spirit and set me down in the middle of the valley."
  - Matthew 4:1 "Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the Devil." Also Mark 1:12, Luke 4:1
  - Acts 16:6 "They went through the region of Phrygia and Galatia and were prevented by the Holy Spirit from speaking the message in the province of Asia."
  - Galatians 5:25 "If we live by the Spirit, we must also follow the Spirit"
  - 1 Kings 18:12 "I don't know where the Spirit of the Lord may carry you when I leave you."
  - 2 Kings 2:16 "Let them go and look for your master. Perhaps the Spirit of the Lord has picked him up and set him down on some mountain or in some valley."
  - Ezekiel 3:12 "Then the Spirit lifted me up" Again 3:14, 8:3, 11:1, 11:24
  - Ezekiel 3:24 "Then the Spirit came into me and raised me to my feet."
  - Ezekiel 43:5 "Then the Spirit lifted me up and brought me into the inner court"
  - Luke 2:27 "Moved by the Spirit, he went into the temple courts."
  - Ezekiel 11:24 "The Spirit lifted me up and brought me to the exiles in Babylonia in the vision given by the Spirit of God."
  - Acts 8:39 "When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord suddenly took Philip away, and the eunuch did not see him again, but went on his way rejoicing."
  - Acts 13:4 "The two of them, sent on their way by the Holy Spirit, went down to Seleucia and sailed from there to Cyprus."
  - Acts 20:22 "And now, compelled by the Spirit, I am going to Jerusalem"
  - Revelation 1:10 "On the Lord's Day I was in the Spirit, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet"
  - Revelation 4:2 "At once I was in the Spirit, and there before me was a throne in heaven with someone sitting on it."
  - Revelation 17:3 "Then the angel carried me away in the Spirit into a wilderness."
  - Revelation 21:10 "And he carried me away in the Spirit to a mountain great and high"
- Bring out the occurrence of the supernatural, or is in close correlation with the supernatural.
  - Joel 2:28 "then your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will have dreams, and your young men will see visions." Peter uses this passage also to explain the phenomenon at Pentecost, namely, speaking in other languages - Acts 2:5-18
  - Gifts of the Spirit, introduced in 1 Corinthians 12:1, gives a list of supernatural activities. 1 Corinthians 12:7 "A manifestation of the Spirit is given to each person to produce what is beneficial" Following this is the list of Spiritual gifts, which are all noted as being by the one and the same Spirit. This goes on through chapter 14, detailing the purpose, function, and workings of these gifts.
  - Acts 2:2-4 "Suddenly a sound like that of a violent rushing wind came from heaven, and it filled the whole house where they were staying. And tongues, like flames of fire that were divided, appeared to them and rested on each one of them. Then they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different languages, as the Spirit gave them ability for speech."
  - Numbers 11:25 "When the Spirit rested on them, they prophesied - but did not do so again."



- Judges 14:6 "The Spirit of the Lord came powerfully upon him so that he tore the lion apart with his bare hands as he might have torn a young goat."
- Judges 14:19 "Then the Spirit of the Lord came powerfully upon him. He went down to Ashkelon, struck down thirty of their men, stripped them of everything and gave their clothes to those who had explained the riddle."
- Judges 15:14 "The Spirit of the Lord came powerfully upon him. The ropes on his arms became like charred flax, and the bindings dropped from his hands."
- 1 Samuel 10:6 "The Spirit of the Lord will come powerfully upon you, and you will prophesy with them; and you will be changed into a different person."
- 1 Samuel 10:10 "the Spirit of God came powerfully upon him, and he joined in their prophesying."
- 1 Samuel 19:20-23 - This passage talks about how people kept on prophesying as the Spirit of God was present. It seems to occur spontaneously.
- 2 Chronicles 15:1 "The Spirit of God came on Azariah son of Oded." After this, Azariah gives a prophecy. Again with Jahaziel in 20:14 Again with Zechariah in 24:20.
- Ezekiel 11:5 "Then the Spirit of the Lord came on me, and he told me to say:"
- Luke 1:67 "His father Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit and prophesied
- Romans 15:19 "by the power of signs and wonders, through the power of the Spirit of God."
- Galatians 3:5 "So again I ask, does God give you his Spirit and work miracles among you by the works of the law, or by your believing what you heard?"
- Ephesians 3:16 "I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being,"
- Hebrews 2:4 "God also testified to it by signs, wonders and various miracles, and by gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to his will."
- Accomplish things
  - Zechariah 3:1 "Not by strength or by might, but by My Spirit"
  - Isaiah 61:1 "The spirit of the Lord God is on Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and freedom to the prisoners" Also Luke 4:14
  - Luke 1:35 "The angel replied to [Mary], 'The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore the holy One to be born will be called the Son of God.'" Again Matthew 1:18, 1:20
  - Isaiah 63:11 "Then his people recalled the days of old, the days of Moses and his people— where is he who brought them through the sea, with the shepherd of his flock? Where is he who set his Holy Spirit among them"
  - Isaiah 31:1 "[Woe] to those who carry out plans that are not mine, forming an alliance, but not by my Spirit, heaping sin upon sin"
  - Micah 3:8 "But as for me, I am filled with power, with the Spirit of the Lord, and with justice and might, to declare to Jacob his transgression, to Israel his sin."
  - Matthew 12:28 "But if it is by the Spirit of God that I drive out demons, then the kingdom of God has come upon you."
  - Romans 7:6 "we have been released from the law so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit"
  - Romans 8:13 "but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body"
  - Philippians 1:19 "for I know that through your prayers and God's provision of the Spirit of Jesus Christ what has happened to me will turn out for my deliverance."

- 2 Timothy 1:7 "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."
- Hebrews 9:14 "Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God"
- Brings freedom
  - 2 Corinthians 3:17 "Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom."
  - Many verses that proclaim what the Spirit does also relates to the Spirit bringing freedom.
  - Romans 8:15 "The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship."
- Baptize us
  - Matthew 3:11 "[Jesus] Himself will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." Again Mark 1:8, Luke 3:16
  - Acts 1:5 "For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."
  - Acts 8:15-19 "When they arrived, they prayed for the new believers there that they might receive the Holy Spirit, because the Holy Spirit had not yet come on any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit. When Simon saw that the Spirit was given at the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money and said, "Give me also this ability so that everyone on whom I lay my hands may receive the Holy Spirit."
  - Acts 11:15-16: "As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit came on them as he had come on us at the beginning. Then I remembered what the Lord had said: 'John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.'"
  - 1 Corinthians 12:13 "For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body"
- Access to the Father
  - Ephesians 2:18 "For through Him we both have access by one Spirit to the Father."
  - Ezekiel 39:29 "I will no longer hide my face from them, for I will pour out my Spirit on the people of Israel"
  - Matthew 12:28 "But if it is by the Spirit of God that I drive out demons, then the kingdom of God has come upon you."
  - Acts 7:55 "But Stephen, full of the Holy Spirit, looked up to heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God."
  - Romans 5:5 "God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us."
  - 1 Corinthians 2:11 "no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God."
  - 1 Corinthians 2:12 "What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may understand what God has freely given us."
- Gives us a new Law, according to His desire
  - Romans 8:2 "because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death."
  - Romans 8:4-5 "because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death. Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires."
- Sanctifies us (set apart, declare Holy)

- Romans 15:16 "so that the Gentiles might become an offering acceptable to God, sanctified by the Holy Spirit."
- 1 Corinthians 3:16 "Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in your midst?"
- 1 Corinthians 6:11 "But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God."
- 1 Peter 1:2 "through the sanctifying work of the Spirit"
- Down payment of our inheritance
  - 2 Corinthians 1:22 "He has also sealed us and given us the Spirit as a down payment in our hearts."
  - 2 Corinthians 5:5 "God, who has given us the Spirit as a deposit"
  - Ephesians 1:14 "[The Holy Spirit] is the down payment of our inheritance, for the redemption of the possession"
  - John 3:5 "Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit.""
  - Acts 2:38 "Peter replied, 'Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.'" This is a response to the question "How do I get saved?"
  - Romans 8:9 "And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ."
- Fills us
  - Ephesians 5:18 "And don't get drunk with wine... but be filled with the Spirit."
  - Acts 2:4 "Then they were all filled with the Holy Spirit"
  - Exodus 31:3 "I have filled him with the Spirit of God" also Exodus 35:31
  - Acts 4:31 "And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly." This passage suggests that being filled with the Spirit is not a one-time deal.
  - Acts 6:3,5 "Brothers and sisters, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to them... They chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit" This passage suggests that to be "full of the Spirit" is noticeable among particular individuals in the church.
  - Acts 9:17 "Brother Saul, the Lord—Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you were coming here—has sent me so that you may see again and be filled with the Holy Spirit."
  - Acts 11:24 "He was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and faith, and a great number of people were brought to the Lord."
  - Acts 13:52 "And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit."
- Forms the church
  - Ephesians 2:22 "And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit."
  - 2 Corinthians 3:14 "May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all."
  - Colossians 1:8 "and who also told us of your love in the Spirit."
- Governs the decisions of the church
  - Acts 15:28 "It seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us not to burden you with anything beyond the following requirements:"
  - Acts 20:28 "Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers."

### Part 3: Other Insights on the Holy Spirit

- The Holy Spirit in the Old Testament can leave a person.
  - 1 Samuel 16:14 "Now the Spirit of the Lord had departed from Saul"
  - Psalm 51:11 "And do not take your Holy Spirit from me."
  - Isaiah 59:21, concerning the coming of Christ "As for me, this is my covenant with them," says the Lord. "My Spirit, who is on you, will not depart from you"
- King David found himself unable to escape God's Spirit - Psalm 139:7-10 "Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? If I ascend to heaven, You are there; If I make my bed in Sheol, behold, You are there. If I take the wings of the dawn, If I dwell in the remotest part of the sea, Even there Your hand will lead me, And Your right hand will lay hold of me."
- God's Spirit was put on Jesus - Isaiah 42:1 "I have put my Spirit on Him", Luke 4:18 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me" Also Matthew 12:18.
- Poured out
  - Joel 2:28 "I will pour out my Spirit on all humanity" Again 2:29, Acts 2:17.
  - Acts 2:33 "Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear."
  - Acts 10:44 "While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came down on all those who heard the message."
  - Isaiah 44:3 "I will pour out my Spirit on your offspring, and my blessing on your descendants."
  - Acts 10:45-47 "While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message. The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on Gentiles. Then Peter said, 47 'Surely no one can stand in the way of their being baptized with water. They have received the Holy Spirit just as we have.'"
  - Titus 3:5-6 "He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior"
- Blasphemy against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven - Matthew 12:32 "But whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him, either in this age, or in the one to come." Also Matthew 12:31, Luke 12:10, Mark 3:29-30. Mark includes: "He said this because they were saying, 'He has an impure spirit.'"
- The Spirit appears like a dove - Luke 3:22 "and the Holy Spirit descended on Him in a physical appearance like a dove" Again Matthew 3:16, Mark 1:10, John
- The Spirit is a seal on us
  - 2 Corinthians 1:22 "He has also sealed us and given us the Spirit as a down payment in our hearts."
  - Ephesians 1:13 "In Him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation - in Him when you believed - were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit."
  - Ephesians 1:17 "When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit,"
- Baptism is meant to be in the name of the Holy Spirit and the rest of the trinity - Matthew 28:19 "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit"
- Given to us by the Father when we ask
  - Luke 11:13 "If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him?"

- 1 Corinthians 6:19 "the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God"
- John 3:34 "For the one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the Spirit without limit."
- John 14:16-17 "And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— the Spirit of truth." Amazingly, Jesus asks for us!
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 "Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God?"
- 2 Corinthians 5:5 "God, who has given us the Spirit as a deposit"
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 "or if you receive a different spirit from the Spirit you received"
- Galatians 3:2 "Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by believing what you heard?"
- Galatians 3:14 "so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit."
- 1 Thessalonians 4:8 "the very God who gives you his Holy Spirit."
- When the Holy Spirit shows up, people often speak in other languages, among other things
  - Acts 2:4 "They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different languages"
  - Acts 10:44-46 "the Holy Spirit came down on all those who heard the message... they heard them speaking in other languages and declaring the greatness of God."
  - Acts 19:5 "they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they began to speak with other languages and to prophesy."
- We are to pray in the Spirit
  - Ephesians 6:18 "With every prayer and request, pray at all times in the spirit, and stay alert in this, with all perseverance and intercession for all the saints."
  - Jude 1:20 "But you, dear friends, by building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit,"
- We are to love by the Spirit
  - Colossians 1:8 "and who also told us of your love in the Spirit."
  - Romans 15:30 "I urge you, brothers and sisters, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit"
- The Spirit did not rest on all people in the Old Testament
  - Numbers 11:29 "I wish that... the Lord would put his Spirit on them."
  - 1 Peter 4:14 "you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you."
- True worshipers worship in the Spirit
  - John 4:23 "Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks."
  - John 4:24 "God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth." (This is NIV. Other translations flip the case of the word "spirit" in this verse.)
  - 1 Corinthians 14:16 "Otherwise when you are praising God in the Spirit,"
  - Ephesians 5:19 "speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit."
  - Colossians 3:16 "Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit"
- The Spirit descends on people
  - Mark 1:10 "He saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit descending to Him like a dove." Luke 3:22

- Numbers 24:2 "When Balaam looked up and saw Israel encamped tribe by tribe, the Spirit of God descended on him"
- The Spirit affected King Saul's emotions -1 Samuel 11:6 "When Saul heard their words, the Spirit of God came powerfully upon him, and he burned with anger."
- We can rebel against the Spirit - Psalm 106:33 "for they rebelled against the Spirit of God"
- Unfathomable - Isaiah 40:13 "Who can fathom the Spirit of the Lord"
- John the Baptist was filled with the Holy Spirit at birth - Luke 1:15 "[John the Baptist] will be filled with the Holy Spirit even before he is born."
- God speaks through the Spirit - Acts 4:25 "You spoke by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of your servant, our father David"
- A position against the church or the gospel is against the Holy Spirit
  - Acts 5:3 "Then Peter said, "Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that you have lied to the Holy Spirit and have kept for yourself some of the money you received for the land?" Again Acts 5:9
  - Acts 7:51 "You stiff-necked people! Your hearts and ears are still uncircumcised. You are just like your ancestors: You always resist the Holy Spirit!"
- The Holy Spirit is an anointing, or comes at an anointing
  - Acts 10:38 "how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power"
  - Isaiah 61:1 "The spirit of the Lord God is on Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to bring good news to the poor.
  - 1 Samuel 16:13 "So Samuel took the horn of oil, anointed him in the presence of his brothers, and the Spirit of the Lord took control of David from that day forward."
- Romans 1:4 "and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by his resurrection from the dead"
- Through Christ
  - Romans 8:2 "because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death."
- We live in the realm of the Spirit "You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you."
- We Live by the Spirit
  - Galatians 5:25 "Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit."
  - Galatians 6:1 "Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently."
